We had a great summer weight room and conditioning workouts. We had 20 players reach the 1000-pound club goal and many more were close. Over 50 players worked hard throughout the summer and most made personal gains in all areas. Brian Viti set a new record in the power clean with a lift of 250 pounds. Many 7^{th} and 8^{th} grade players lifted with the Varsity during the Spring. With 70 players on the team, we are looking for good depth this year.

Over the summer, we had several players play in All-Star games. Ryan Helfrich (SE) and Robbie Leonard (DB) played in the Penn-Ohio Classic which was played this year in Salem, Ohio. The game was won by the Pennsylvania Team. Ryan had one of the touchdowns and caught several balls during the game. Robbie had some key knockdowns from his defensive back position and one interception. Ryan will be attending Slippery Rock to play basketball and Robbie will attend Washington & Jefferson (W&J) and will play football.

Another player that played in an All-Star game was A.Q. Shipley. AQ was the fourth football player in the history of Moon High School to be picked to play in the Big 33 game in Hershey. This is a very prestigious game that is played each July with a team from Ohio. This year's game was close, with Ohio winning. Besides starting as defensive tackle for the PA squad, AQ was chosen captain for the game by his teammates. Mr. Shipley will be playing this fall for Penn State.

Over the last ten years, only one team in AAA football has had a non-losing record every year. This same team has been to the playoffs 9 of the last 10 years. In those 10 years, this team has compiled an 83 - 31 record or .728 winning percentage. This team has built a strong tradition of winning and will continue that tradition this season.
